60 Puzzle Pieces


- Daniel 10-12 provides the last known glimpse of Daniel's life.

- Today you will see what he saw and connect dots.




- •A remnant returned to Israel in 537BC.

- •In verses 13-19, we get a closer look at "Antiochus the Great," whose activities profoundly affected Israel.















APPLICATION

- •The level of prophetic precision in Daniel 11:1-20 causes some to say, "It had to be written after the fact."
- •For example: "Daniel" was written by a second century BC writer (not Daniel) to encourage Israel.

APPLICATION

- •Though written as if it referred to the future, it was "known history cast in the form of prophecy, and it may very well be that the more instructed readers of the book were quite aware of this" Porteus.
- •There is just one problem!

APPLICATION

- •Jesus disagrees!
- •"Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through **Daniel the prophet,** standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains." (Matthew 24:15–16).

APPLICATION

- •According to Jesus, Daniel is a prophet!
- •Here is how prophesy works: And he [one of the bowl-bearing angels] said to me, "These words are faithful and true;" and the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show to His bond-servants the things which must soon take place (Revelation 22:6).

APPLICATION

- •According to Jesus, Daniel 11 prophesies events that can be clearly connected to future history.
- •Something mentioned in Daniel 11, when identified as a current event, requires a particular and immediate action response.

APPLICATION

- •Daniel 11:1-20 provides authentication by a factor of 60.
- •How much more "faithful and true" can you get?
- •Our adversary does not want you to have this information which bolsters trust and reliance on God.

APPLICATION

- •Raising doubts and questions about what God has said has been part of his strategy **from** the very beginning.
- •Viewing Daniel 11:1-20 as "faithful and true" unlocks the full benefit of the information in the entire chapter.

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
