These notes suggest ways you can discuss the sermon preached on February 6, 2022, at First Evangelical Church in Memphis, TN. Feel free to use them for a class or small group discussion. Pick just one question or use them all.

- 1. Read Numbers 22–24. What was Balak's objective? What was his intention in contacting Balaam? How did that work out? Based on Numbers 31:16, how did Balaam set up the events that are recorded in Numbers 25:1–18?
- 2. What was really going on as recorded in Numbers 25:1–3? Were the Moabites genuinely interested in Israel's good and sponsoring a good relationship with them? How do you know your answer is correct? Have you ever encountered someone who seemed to be encouraging a friendship but who was actually working against your good? What happened?
- 3. God's remedy for the plague which broke out required that leadership be killed in broad daylight as atonement? What would go through your mind if God asked you to administer such a penalty? What would make you hesitate? What would motivate you?
- 4. In what way is the worship of Baal-Peor similar to influences in our culture? In what ways is the church at risk of these cultural influences? How does Revelation 2:14–15 add to your understanding of what threatens the church?
- 5. Pastor Jim will use this incident to illustrate a principle: All in for God = God with you. What does this mean? What does this mean for you? In what way are you currently facing a challenge in your devotion to God alone? Share with each other principles that could help someone stay all in for God when the culture is challenging that devotion?
- 6. If you were a Phinehas, what would that look like in your life? What would you do differently? What could you do to become more of a Phinehas?
